# PROJECT PATTERN BARREL BAG - FINAL ASSEMBLY 



## Printing Instruction

The pattern is designed to be printable. We took into consideration the standard printer margin for letter and A4 sized papers.
Seletct "US letter" or "A4" under paper size. Make sure portrait mode is selected.
Be sure to click "scale: 100\%" to ensure that the page is going to print to scale.

Recommended Leather Weight
$1.6 \mathrm{~mm} \sim 2.0 \mathrm{~mm}(4 \sim 5 \mathrm{oz})$

## Instruction

1. Trace pattern into leather and cut out side pieces.
2. Skive down the edges.
3. Cut four leather strips, mark join location then skive the ends.
4. Punch stitching holes on the leather strip and round off the opposite edge with edge beveler.
5. Apply leather adhesive along the grain (smooth) side edge and glue the trim strip.
6. Use lacing nipper to push the holes through. Stitch the trim and side panel together. Shape the assembly with your finger.
7. Glue side assembly to the body panel and stitch together.
8. Repeat the above steps to complete the other side.
9. Sand off uneven area with sanding stick and apply edge base coat. Allow to dry.
10. Apply edge coat and top coat to finish the edges.
11. Complete.
