## PROJECT PATTERN BURGUNDY TOTE HAND DYED HANDLE STRAP (PART II)




## Printing Instruction

The pattern is designed to be printable. We took into consideration the standard printer margin for letter \& A4 sized papers.
Seletct "US letter" or "A4" under paper size. Make sure portrait mode is selected.
Be sure to click "scale: 100\%" to ensure that the page is going to print to scale.

## Recommended Leather Weight

1. $0.8 \sim 1.2 \mathrm{~mm}(2 \sim 3 \mathrm{oz})$
2. 2.0 ~ $2.4 \mathrm{~mm}(5 \sim 6 \mathrm{oz})$

## Instruction

1. Trim the top lining seam at 45 degree angle. Do the same for the other side. Apply glue along the seam, fold and flatten the seam with roller.
2. Apply glue along the top edge of the lining, as well as the top edge of the bag.
3. Insert lining into the bag, glue and fold the bag edge inward and overlap the lining edge. Flatten with leathercraft hammer.
4. Use stitching awl to pierce through stitching holes and stitch the seam.
5. Trace and cut out leather tabs. Punch holes and apply adhesive in the center.
6. Fold and place the tab over side seam, punch holes and fasten with rivets. Do the same on the other side.
7. Round off the end of the strap and punch button stud holes. Bevel the edges and burnish with slicker.
8. Apply Fenice diamond waterstain with a sponge and allow to dry.
9. Attach the straps and complete.
