


PROJECT PATTERN BURGUNDY TOTE HAND DYED HANDLE STRAP (PART II)



Printing Instruction

The pattern is designed to be printable. We took into consideration the standard printer margin for letter & A4 sized papers.

Seletct "US letter" or "A4" under paper size. Make sure portrait mode is selected.

Be sure to click "scale: 100%" to ensure that the page is going to print to scale.



Recommended Leather Weight

1. 0.8 ~ 1.2mm (2 ~ 3oz) 2. 2.0 ~ 2.4mm (5 ~ 6oz)

Instruction

- 1. Trim the top lining seam at 45 degree angle. Do the same for the other side. Apply glue along the seam, fold and flatten the seam with roller.
- 2. Apply glue along the top edge of the lining, as well as the top edge of the bag.
- 3. Insert lining into the bag, glue and fold the bag edge inward and overlap the lining edge. Flatten with leathercraft hammer.
- 4. Use stitching awl to pierce through stitching holes and stitch the seam.
- 5. Trace and cut out leather tabs. Punch holes and apply adhesive in the center.
- 6. Fold and place the tab over side seam, punch holes and fasten with rivets. Do the same on the other side
- 7. Round off the end of the strap and punch button stud holes. Bevel the edges and burnish with slicker.
- 8. Apply Fenice diamond waterstain with a sponge and allow to dry.
- 9. Attach the straps and complete.
