


PROJECT PATTERN LEATHER TABLE SETTING



Printing Instruction

This project pattern is scaled to fit on letter & A4 size papers. You can print out the instruction and use the dimension as a guideline to create the actual size template.



Instruction

Tools & material available on www.ivan.tw

- 1. Follow the instruction to create 1:1 scale pattern and cut out each piece.
- 2. Select your leather. We're using Horween Cascade Brown Leather for this project.
- 3. Trace templates into leather, cut out each piece and set aside.

A. LEATHER PLACEMAT

- 1. Take the placemat panel and round off the corner 4. Bevel the edges with edge beveler and polish with corner punch.
- adjust the cutting widths.
- 3. Cut a decorative groove around the edges of the placemat.
- with gum tragacanth and edge slicker.
- 2. Set stitching groover with cutting blade and 5. Applya finish top coat and allow to dry completely.

B. LEATHER CHARGER

- 1. Measure the diameter of your mold and rough cut your leather. (Pattern is not included. Our rough cut size is 330 X 330mm)
- 2. Use circle marking template with two scratch awls. Place one in the center and use the other to scribe the circle. Size the circle according to your mold. Be sure to leave some extra room.
- 3. Soak the leather disc in water, allow the water to saturate the leather so it becomes pliable.
- 4. Place the leather disc in the mold and use your

C. PLACE CARD

- 1. Install the modeling spoon on your stitching groover, and mark a decorative line along the edges.
- 2. Bevel the edges with edge beveler.
- 3. Select the desire letters from your brass imprinting set and install into the brass type holder.
- 4. Mark an embossing guideline and cut off a piece of foil that is large enough to cover the text.

D. LEATHER UTENSIL HOLDER

Fools & material available on www.ivan.tw

- 1. Take the Utensil Holder panel and bevel the edges with edge beveler. Polish with gum tragacanth, slicker and glass burnisher.
- 2. Mark the folding line on the flesh side.
- 3. Fold top to the line, fold and overlap the bottom slightly over the top edge. Use leathercraft hammer to flatten the edges.
- 4. Punch 6 hardware holes using rotary punch.
- 5. Insert rivets and use setter and anvil to set the hardware in place.

hand and blunt end of the slicker to work the disc into the mold gently.

- 5. Set aside and allow the leather to dry completely.
- 6. Mark a trim line with a scratch awl and trim off the excess.
- 7. Apply top coat and allow to dry.
- 8. Bevel the edges and burnish with slicker.
- 9. Seal the back with gum tragacanth.
- 5. Set your Craftpus Hot Stamp and Foil Imprinter to 120~125 degress. Be sure to test on a piece of scrap before application.
- 6. Place place card into the machine and pull down the handle. Replace this step 1-2 times to build up the foil.
- 7. Apply top finish and allow to dry.
- 8. Fold and crease the place card using bond folder.

- 6. Mark 4mm wide stitching lines and punch holes on both sides.
- Measure the seam five times with thread and cut out 4 thread pieces and set aside.
- 8. Stitch the seam together using saddle stitch. Repeat the same step for all four seams.
- 9. Apply gum tragacanth to the edges and polish with wooden slicker.




