
PROJECT PATTERN DIY DOG COLLARS




Printing Instruction

The pattern is designed to be printable. We took into consideration the standard printer margin for letter & A4 sized papers.

Select "US letter" or "A4" under paper size. Make sure portrait mode is selected.

Be sure to click "scale: 100%" to ensure that the page is going to print to scale.



3.6mm~4.0mm (9~10oz)

Instruction

Print out the pattern on heavy card stock, cut out the pieces & trace into leather.

DIY DOG COLLARS

- Cut out leather panels (glue the back on buckle strap only) & trim off the edges.
- 3. Polish the edges with gum trag & slicker.
- 4. Punch buckle hole on buckle panel.
- 5. We recommend 3mm wide guideline for stitching. Punch all stitching holes.
- 6. Apply leather adhesive along webbing strap & fold the edges.
- 7. Cut webbing to length & sew onto webbing strap.
- 8. Place webbing strap in between buckle hole strap, punch holes & stitch together.
- 9. Add dee into keeper loop & stitch the ends together.
- 10. Glue buckle strap to the other end, punch holes & stitch together.
- 11. Add keeper, buckle, dee, & stitch the straps together.
- 12. Punch holes & fasten grommet using setter & anvil.
- 13. Punch out two round leather shapes & glue together. Polish the edge.
- 14. Punch out a center hole & screw on your desired concho.
- 15. Attach leather tag onto collar with split ring.


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Measure this ruler against you own to make sure the pattern is to scale.

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
